

National Disaster Resilience Framework (Drafted)

The National Disaster Response Framework (NDRF)

- Establishes effective coordination and implementation of disaster preparedness and response activities by developing a National Disaster Response plan
- Specifies the roles and responsibilities of Government and Non Government agencies involved in disaster risk management in Nepal.
- "actions taken immediately before, during and after the disasters, or directly to save lives and property;
- maintain law and order; care for sick, injured and vulnerable people; provide essential services (lifeline utilities, food, shelter. public information and media); and
- protect public property
- Cluster Activation—11 Clusters made headed by the ministries

- preparedness and emergency response at national, provincial, district and local level.
- National Council, Executive Committee, NDRRMA as Secretariat
- Provincial Council, Executive committee
- District Disaster management Committee
- Local Disaster management Committee
